NEW STUDENT Application Checklist

Final acceptance is contingent upon following all steps below. A Letter of Acceptance will be sent once all criteria are met.

STEP 1- Mail the following items (retain a copy of this checklist for your reference):

- Family Application
- One Student Application per child
- Parental Agreement form (signed by both parents)
- Complete a Tentative Course Plan for each student for the upcoming school year
- Check for the total fees due (see the Fee Schedule & Calculator below)
- Photocopy of Birth Certificate for each child
- **For students entering grades 1 – 9:** Most current Transcript/Report Card (if transferring from a public or private/umbrella school) or most recent test scores or portfolio evaluation (if homeschooled). *Note: These reports/scores may be from either Spring 2010 or Fall 2010 if the Spring 2011 results are not yet available.*
- **For students entering grades 10 or 11:** Contact us for instructions before submitting your application.

STEP 2 – Attend a mandatory Informational Meeting

- You will be contacted and scheduled for a meeting once your application is reviewed
- At least one parent must attend

STEP 3 – Attend a Family Consultation or Phone Contact (as determined by the Veritas Advisor)

- Most students entering grades K through 8 will only require a Phone Contact after the Informational Meeting
- Students entering grades 9 – 11 will require a personal Family Consultation to discuss high school plans

STEP 4 – Mail (or bring to consultation) any missing/required/outstanding items such as:

- Immunization records (the “Blue” form)
- Current school physical form (less than 3 years old) – the “beige” form

By signing, we attest that all answers submitted on this form are true and accurate and we agree to the following:

- As a condition for maintaining enrollment, I agree to submit true and accurate information at all times and will be bound to the responsibilities as listed in this application. I will assure that a letter of Withdrawal is submitted to our previous school when enrolling my child at Veritas Academy and understand my child is automatically withdrawn from Veritas Academy should he/she be enrolled elsewhere.
- Veritas Academy shall not be responsible for the education of students enrolled and I will provide all curricula and educational activities or tests along with associated costs.
- I hold harmless Veritas Academy from any and all claims of liability resulting from services provided or not provided, errors, omissions, or referrals made by Veritas Academy.
- I understand that if a student misses evaluations or testing, or is missing monthly reports, transcripts will be stamped Incomplete.
- My child may be removed from enrollment, or enrollment denied or rescinded, at the discretion of the School Administration.
- Veritas Academy reserves the right to review or request any information or records for the purpose of processing the Application, or obtaining transcripts or student records; and I agree to provide assistance in obtaining information or records for the same.
- **All fees will be paid as assessed and are non-refundable.** A tuition check that is returned as NSF will result in immediate dismissal from the school.
- Custody or guardianship of the student(s) is held solely by me/us, the natural or adoptive parent(s) or legal guardian(s) with whom the child lives. I/We, the legal guardian(s) or parent(s) of the student(s) in the application have not been convicted of child abuse, neglect or endangerment, and upon any incident of the same, occurring after this date, I/we will inform Veritas Academy.
- Monthly reports must be received by the 10th of each month. Non submission, late submission, or incomplete monthly reports will result in a **late notice and a \$20.00 fine**. Lack of response to the late notice will result in suspension/dismissal from the school on the 25th of the month.
- I understand that failure to comply with the school regulations and policies are cause for suspension/dismissal of student(s) with no refund of monies paid to the school. School records will then be stamped incomplete.
- In the event that a student is reinstated after a suspension, there will be a \$50 reinstatement fine. More than two suspensions will result in expulsion from the school.
- If I wish to withdraw my student(s) from Veritas Academy, I will immediately inform the school of my intent to withdraw and will fulfill all policies and requirements regarding withdrawal. All fees must be satisfied for records to be released.

As teachers of our enrolled children, we also agree to the following:

1. To teach the required 180 days of school per year.
2. To make available the student's work of inspection upon request of school staff.
3. To teach the required number of hours pertaining to grade level per year.
4. To maintain high quality academic standards using a recognizable program of study.
5. To teach minimum subject areas of Bible, math, history, science and English.
6. To keep the daily attendance and grades of each student in my class.
7. To submit a monthly report of daily attendance and average monthly grades.
8. To attend any meeting that the Administration deems necessary.
9. To complete an annual evaluation or standardized testing provided by Veritas Academy, the SAT, ACT or CPT, as deemed appropriate by the School.
10. To provide adult supervision for children up to and including the age of fifteen, during the school year.
11. To have all immunization records and physicals up to date and into the office by September 1 of the current school year, or accept our child's dismissal from the school with no refund.

I/We release Veritas Academy of Central Florida, Inc. from any and all responsibility and absolve them from any claim or loss, damage, or injury of any nature to person or property resulting from the school program. I/We also agree that the school shall not be liable for any loss or unintentional neglect or careless acts of any school personnel.
